GELATINE WARNING

Gelatine is used in a multitude of food and beverage products. This “*sticky*” ingredient maybe sourced from either Halaal or Haraam raw material. When sourced from Halaal Thabeehah raw material, its status is undisputed and acceptable to all; however when sourced from non-Halaal and/or Haraam raw material, there are some who accept such product on the basis of transformation/metamorphosis whilst majority of Halaal certification bodies globally do not permit such gelatine. Unfortunately, it is not mandatory by law to state the source of the gelatine on product labelling except to list it as, “*gelatine, stabilizer or gelling agent, etc.*” This situation has resulted in numerous products in the marketplace containing Haraam porcine-gelatine that consumers may not be aware of. Consumption of Haraam, albeit unknowingly, most certainly has negative effects on ones spirituality.
