DON'T COUNT YOUR CHICKENS BEFORE THEY ARE CERTIFIED

South Africa is one of the world's leading consumers of chicken and poultry is its largest agricultural industry. About 5 million birds are slaughtered daily which caters for 75% of the demand while the remaining 25% is imported from the EU, USA, Brazil, Argentina and other countries from time to time.

Alhumdulillah! with the vision and blessings of our pious Ulama predecessors, efforts were made more than 50 years ago to regulate the predominantly non-Muslim meat and poultry industry for the provision of Halaal for consumers and traders alike. This has resulted in almost all slaughter at commercial abattoirs in the country being done by hand with Muslim slaughterers under Muslim supervision. Whilst the 75% is covered under Halaal certification, it is the imported unregulated and the illegal black market that is a very serious threat to the integrity of the Halaal market. Just this past weekend, criminals were arrested for fraud and corruption with a consignment of 27 000 Kgs of imported poultry labelled as Halaal.
